<b>Writing</b>	<p><b>Use adjectives</b></p> <p>This week we are flying to Antarctica!</p> <p>Listen to the story of '<a href="#">The Emperors Egg</a>'.</p> <p>Watch this <a href="#">video</a> if you would like to see a real baby penguin hatching. Imagine you're a baby penguin inside an egg- can you act hatching out of your egg into the Antarctic?</p> <p>What would you do/see/hear once you had hatched?</p> <p>Write a description using adjectives to describe what you can see, hear, feel and smell!</p>	<p><b>Act in role</b></p> <p>Listen to the story '<a href="#">Lost and Found</a>.'</p> <p>Choose your favourite character in the story- the boy or the penguin- and think about how they feel in different parts of the story.</p> <p>Take on the role of that character and try and act like them. Can someone in your family ask questions for you to answer as your character?</p>	<p><b>Write a letter</b></p> <p>Listen to the story of '<a href="#">Lost and Found</a>' again.</p> <p>Think about when the boy leaves the penguin in the South Pole. What is the penguin thinking?</p> <p>Imagine you are the penguin. Write a letter to the boy to persuade him to come back and get you.</p>	<p><b>Plan a story</b></p> <p>In the story 'Lost and Found' the boy opens his front door to find an animal. Imagine that you hear a knock on your door. You open the door and find a strange animal there. What would happen next?</p> <p>Plan your own version of 'Lost and Found' including</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What is the animal?</li> <li>• Where do you take them?</li> <li>• How do you get there?</li> <li>• What happens in the end?</li> </ul>	<p><b>Write a story</b></p> <p>Use your story plan to write your own 'Lost and Found' story. Don't forget to use story language to make your story more exciting!</p>

### Example

- How did you feel when you couldn't find the penguin?

Penguin

- Why did you go to the boy's house?
- How did you feel when he took you back to the South Pole?
- What do you want to do now?

### Challenge





Dear boy,
