Session 1 Online	Safer Internet Week- How do you stay safe when searching for something online? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Think – How can we stay safe when searching for something online? • Listen to the Detective Digi Duck story. • Think - What does Wise Owl tell the group to do if they are unsure about something online? Look at his top tips for searching online. • Create your own presentation of Wise Owl's advice for being safe online. You could create a poster, record a video or even create your own song. 	
Session 2 Online	Safer Internet Week- Can we trust everyone we speak to online? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Think – Can we trust everyone we speak to online? • Listen to the story Digi Duck's Famous Friend • Activity – Try to remember the events in the story to answer the questions below. You could write, video or voice record your answers. 	
Session 3 Mental Health	How can you express yourself? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Watch this video to learn about what mental health is and how we can express ourselves. • Choose one of the following activities that you would like to try • Create a dance, sing a song, listen to a new song, listen to some music and draw, paint a picture or write a poem. • Remember to choose something that makes you feel good. 	
Session 4 Finance	How can we keep our money safe? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Imagine- Your friend Tom has received £5 as a gift for his birthday. How do you think Tom would feel when he received this money? • Think - Where could Tom keep this money, to keep it safe? • Look at the 'Places to keep money safe' cards in resource 4 and sort the cards into two piles – <i>safe</i> and <i>not safe</i>. • Why is it important to keep money safe? 	
Session 5 Finance	How can we choose to spend our money? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Look at the pictures in resource 5a. If you could buy one of these, which would you choose? Next, ask someone in your family, which toy would they choose? • Look at the 'What influences my choice?' worksheet in resource 5b. Draw a picture of the toy you want and then circle the statements which would encourage you to buy it. • Look at the scenarios in resource 5c. Which choice would you make and why? • What is it important to think about before spending money?
