Audience: yourself Purpose: to remember When writing your letter, remember to: • Start with 'Dear' and end with 'from' • Explain why you are writing • Use lots of descriptive details (including noun phrases) • Use conjunctions to write longer and more detailed sentences Some suggestions of what to write about: • Fun activities you have done with your family • Something new you've experienced • Your favourite thing you have learnt about • A new skill you have developed • An act of kindness you have done • A book you have read and enjoyed • Special occasions you have celebrated and how	Today you are going to interview a family member and write up your questions and their answers (see resource 5A for example template). 


